FULL TEXT: 100% full text database. Users can download full text of every study in the database at no additional cost.	LINKS and BIBLIOGRAPHY: Bibliographical database with links (when available) to journals' content.
UNIQUE CONTENT: LatAm-Studies has more than 90 full-text journals.	CONTENT: Only 25% are indexed by HAPI.
GROWTH: LatAm-Studies is growing at a rate of over 35% annually. Last year, 7,737 full text records were added. This year, the estimate is 9,000 records. Additionally, 1,700 were already indexed in a new section, bringing the expected total to over 10,700 records added this year alone.	GROWTH: Records indicate that HAPI adds approximately 7,000 records/year at a flat rate of growth since 2012.
UPDATES: LatAm-Studies updates and performs full update uploads on a bi-weekly basis.	UPDATES: Batch uploads are implemented at unspecified intervals.
DIGITIZED CONTENT: LatAm-Studies digitizes journals back to the first issue to ensure preservation of key historical texts and expand availability. ²	DIGITIZED CONTENT: None
FREE INTERNET CONTENT: LatAm-Studies partners with peer reviewed free Internet based journals to incorporate such content in the new section LATAMPLUS, which is available at no additional cost. ³	FREE INTERNET CONTENT: None.
